2005 total membership was 2,598. To date, our totals are 1,464- youth, 742- adults, equally 2,206. There were 82 club memberships in 2005. To date, there 88 club memberships, 12 of those being organizational members. There were 150 sanctions in 2005 and 143 to date. We are expected to surpass 2005.

Sanction fees will be raised by the association by \$5.00. This will be posted on the Colorado page.

There will be a mandated fee raise in USATF memberships- \$19.95 for youth and \$29.95 for adults. If 2006 memberships are updated before November 1, 2006, the fees will only be \$15.00 for youth and \$20.00 for adults.
